



## *USES OF COOKIES*

Websites use cookies to provide the functionality you need to browse our site correctly. Websites issue cookies upon landing on our websites unless the user has changed cookie settings in their browser to refuse cookies. Please note that with cookies switched off, many areas of our website and services will not be made available to you.

We do not use cookies to collect personally identifiable information about you – the cookies that we use only collect anonymous information to optimize our services and do not collect personal information.

Please note that not all the cookies on our sites are set by us. Please see the section below on third party cookies.

## *TYPES OF COOKIE*

- Session cookies
- Analytical cookies
- Functional cookies
- Third party cookies

1. **SESSION** cookies save website 'session' credentials for visitors both logged in and not logged in. Once the browser is closed, the cookie is deactivated – and the session closed.

2. **ANALYTICAL** cookies collect visitor information, such as the number of visits, how our website was found, from where the visit came from, if via a marketing campaign etc. This information is extremely important to the business and helps us improve our website and further enhance visitor experience.

3. **FUNCTIONAL** cookies are specifically about visitor experience on the website. For example, they 'remember' the open/closed status of pop up messages, what time zone or view state was set for the Economic Calendar, enabling access to information stored when registered with us and so on. Without these functional cookies, no settings information can be saved.

4. **THIRD PARTY** cookies are set by other websites who place cookies on the user's computer. The "3rd party" cookies are placed when you are logged into their service, and we do not control the dissemination of these cookies.
